AUSTRALIA Pray for the work of The Leprosy Mission Australia. Pray for God's provision and wisdom as we join with other Australians, and organisations both here and overseas to bring healing and dignity.

Friday September 5

NEPAL Give thanks for health care workers building their skills to diagnose leprosy, leading to more cases being found. Pray for improved ability to deal with complications that arise once patients are on Multi-Drug Therapy.

NEPAL Pray for new strategies to increase leprosy awareness and knowledge among young students. Pray for a national education approach to effectively run a program to reach all students.

Thursday September 11

NEPAL Give thanks for the team at Nepal Leprosy Fellowship who run the Jhapa Leprosy Reduction project that your prayers support.

Pray they will have resources, wisdom, and energy to reach their goals and reduce leprosy transmission in children.
