GLOBAL Pray for The Leprosy Mission International team who support the work of the Global Fellowship, helping countries overcome challenges, work collaboratively, and create better outcomes for people affected by leprosy.

Wednesday June 3

GLOBAL Pray for Leprosy Mission teams around the world to have the resources needed to travel to remote or hard to reach locations. Pray that difficult economic conditions will not impact their work in bringing help, dignity, and love to affected people.

Thursday June 4

AUSTRALIA Give thanks for the goodness of God in His provision when we ask in trust and faith. Pray for blessings to be bestowed upon all who treat leprosy sufferers, and for those who support and work for the Mission. – Ann H., – VIC

Friday June 5

GLOBAL On World Environment Day give thanks for training and innovation for Self-Help Groups and farmers to improve their agricultural practices. Pray this will bring sustainable outcomes.

Saturday June 6

AUSTRALIA Dear Father in heaven, look upon your people suffering from this terrible disease, and those committed to helping them. Please provide all that is needed to improve their situation and strengthen and improve the ability of The Leprosy Mission Australia to help. Sunday June 7

GLOBAL On World Food Safety Day pray for under resourced communities affected by leprosy, other NTDs, and disabilities to have their daily food needs met. Pray for access to fresh food and water to build health and reduce illness.

Monday June 8

INDIA Pray for The Leprosy Mission Trust India as they expand their advocacy efforts. Pray for financial and human resources needed to raise awareness and champion the rights of people affected by leprosy.

Tuesday June 9

NEPAL Pray for the various medical teams as they navigate difficult times with some operating out of Anandaban, and others in Kathmandu. Pray they remain safe and connected as they provide essential services, research, and support.

Wednesday June 10

NIGERIA Pray for teams traveling around the country during times of insecurity, both

locally and internationally. Pray that safety will be maintained, and that cost of living will not prevent outreach and services from being provided.

Thursday June 11

GLOBAL On International Day of Play pray that children with leprosy will not be excluded by friends, schools, neighbours, or family and that they would be free to play and enjoy their childhood.

Friday June 12

NIGERIA Pray for ongoing relationships with local community leaders who contribute greatly to mobilising community participation in outreach activities.

Saturday June 13

NIGERIA Pray for improved conditions in underserved communities, especially access to safe water and adequate sanitation facilities.

Sunday June 14

PAPUA NEW GUINEA Pray for the work of Natalie Smith and her team, as they continue to strengthen relationships with local healthcare workers and community groups including the new Organisation of Persons with Leprosy.

Monday June 15

NEPAL June marks the beginning of the monsoon season in Nepal. Pray for safety for Leprosy Mission teams and our partners at Nepal Leprosy Fellowship, over the next two months.

Tuesday June 16

AUSTRALIA Pray for staff during this busiest time of year. Pray that activities to raise awareness and funds will be effective as together with you we aim to be the generation to see an end to leprosy.

Wednesday June 17

GLOBAL Pray for our partner organisations such as Nepal Leprosy Fellowship and Yayasan NLR Indonesia as we continue to collaborate, ensuring more people with leprosy are found, treated, and supported to live full lives.

Thursday June 18

GLOBAL On International Day for Countering Hate Speech pray that laws discriminating against people with leprosy will be repealed, that myths, and misunderstandings will be replaced by truth, love, and inclusion.

Friday June 19

TIMOR-LESTE Pray that training for health care workers in Oecusse will bear fruit with increased leprosy awareness in communities and more people coming forward for diagnosis, treatment, and support.

Saturday June 20

TIMOR-LESTE Pray for children to be educated about leprosy through their school curriculum. Pray this will reduce stigma and increase inclusion in the playground and at home.

Sunday June 21

NEPAL Pray for patients needing counselling and support to thrive in their communities. Pray for sufficient resources to provide this level of quality care that can help transform lives.

Monday June 22

NEPAL Pray for members of Self-Help Groups to grow in confidence to establish their own businesses and create a sustainable livelihood for themselves and their families.

Tuesday June 23

INDONESIA Pray for people living in informal settlements where living conditions are overcrowded and inadequate. Pray people with leprosy in these communities can access health services that have a good understanding of leprosy.

Wednesday June 24

INDONESIA Pray for the project team from partner Yayasan NLR as they conduct leprosy screening in rural villages, as well as in informal urban settlements. Pray for strong community support so that more people can be diagnosed.

Thursday June 25

INDIA Pray for students at the Faizabad Vocational Training Centre to be well prepared with the necessary skills to successfully gain employment following graduation.

Friday June 26

AUSTRALIA Give thanks and pray for supporters who express their love in so many ways, such as prayer, shopping, giving, fundraising, encouraging others, and volunteering. Pray God will bless them as they continue to be the hands and feet of Jesus.

Saturday June 27

GLOBAL Give thanks for churches and community groups who faithfully make a difference through prayer, having a guest speaker, giving, and keeping informed. Pray more churches and groups will join this vital effort to end leprosy.

Sunday June 28

AUSTRALIA Give thanks for the hard work put in this financial year by The Leprosy Mission Staff to meet commitments for the projects you support. Pray this will result in breakthroughs, transformation, and freedom for people affected by leprosy.

Monday June 29

GLOBAL On International Day of the Tropics pray for all those affected by Neglected Tropical Diseases such as leprosy. Pray for awareness to be raised, for governments and other agencies to provide resources for more people to be treated.
