Sunday August 2

NEPAL Pray for opportunities to integrate leprosy screening with other health conditions to remove potential stigma within schools and other settings. Pray for increased awareness of leprosy and its cure and treatment.

Monday August 3

GLOBAL Give thanks for the growth of Organisations of Persons Affected by Leprosy. Pray for their leadership to have wisdom to lead well, opportunities to be heard, and the support of their members and the wider community.

Tuesday August 4

INDONESIA Pray for the new leadership of our partner Yayasan NLR to continue activities and maintain momentum in the projects you support to provide advocacy, education, and improved healthcare services.

Wednesday August 5

INDONESIA Give thanks for opportunities to develop relationships with companies in the Karawang District where the Comprehensive Zero Leprosy Project (Co-ZLP) operates. Pray for the chance to improve awareness and early

detection in workplace settings.

Thursday August 6

GLOBAL Pray for Organisations of Persons Affected by Leprosy as they advocate, speaking with governments, organisations, and influential community members. Pray their experiences and knowledge will be taken seriously by decision makers.

Friday August 7

GLOBAL Pray for the Boards of The Leprosy Mission teams around the Global Fellowship. Pray for God to fill them with wisdom, that they will lead with integrity, and that their efforts will multiply the impact of the Mission.

PAPUA NEW GUINEA Pray for Natalie Smith and her team as they build partnerships with community leaders and train health volunteers in villages across PNG.

NEPAL Pray for the members of the Self-Help Groups as they provide a positive influence in their communities. Pray their efforts will increase leprosy awareness and encourage people in their families and neighbourhoods to be tested and supported.

Wednesday August 12

GLOBAL On International Youth Day pray for the many ways in which you support young people through The Leprosy Mission Australia such as scholarships, school screening for leprosy, vocational training, and advocacy.

Thursday August 13

GLOBAL Pray that as a Global Fellowship we continue to consider the needs of the whole person; for physical healing and health, for inner wellbeing, for spiritual health, as well as practical needs around care, education, vocation, and community inclusion.

Friday August 14

AUSTRALIA Pray for The Leprosy Mission Australia conference today and tomorrow as people gather to hear the latest news, celebrate victories, acknowledge the challenges still facing our work, and pray deeply for God's will to be done.

Sunday August 16

GLOBAL Pray for ongoing work to develop new medications including a vaccine. Pray for funding, trials, partnerships, and other resources needed over the next few years to bring us breakthroughs in treatments and possible prevention of leprosy.

Monday August 17

NIGERIA Pray for The Leprosy Mission Nigeria teams as they live out their mission to follow Jesus in bringing transformation to people affected by leprosy and creating a more inclusive society where people can live life in all its fullness.

Tuesday August 18

NIGERIA Give thanks and pray for outreach opportunities through television and radio to educate communities about Water, Sanitation, and Hygiene (WASH) programs, and awareness around leprosy and other Neglected Tropical Diseases.

Wednesday August 19

GLOBAL On World Humanitarian Day give thanks and pray for people who step in to help others during times of crises. Pray for safety and protection for workers and those who they are serving. Pray for leaders around the world to provide resources and support.

Thursday August 20

INDIA Pray for breakthroughs in leprosy awareness, diagnosis and treatment so that affected people can reclaim dignity and belonging in

their communities. Pray for education, livelihood support, advocacy and resources to live full lives.

Friday August 21

INDIA Pray for the thousands of children diagnosed with leprosy each year. Pray they will get the treatment and support they need to avoid stigma and disability, complete their education, find meaningful employment, and contribute to their communities.

Saturday August 22

INDIA Pray for the staff and students of the Vocational Training Centre Faizabad. Pray that the centre will have the resources to provide quality training and education, and for students to find meaningful employment opportunities.

Sunday August 23

AUSTRALIA Pray for more churches and groups to promote and support the work of The Leprosy Mission through prayer, speaking engagements, and events.

Monday August 24

GLOBAL Pray each of us will look to God's wisdom and guidance as we pray, as we give, as we share with others. Pray people affected by leprosy, discrimination, and disability will experience the love of God through our actions.

Tuesday August 25

TIMOR-LESTE Give thanks for the refurbishment of the healthcare clinic in Oecusse. Pray for the positive impact this will have in bringing holistic care to local communities.

GLOBAL Pray for research into the effects of stigma and discrimination on mental health for people living with leprosy. Pray for studies in these areas to lead to reduced stigma and improved mental health.

GLOBAL Pray that the research conducted by The Leprosy Mission and their partners will be of the highest standard and be taken seriously by governments and other stakeholders to improve ongoing treatment and support for affected people.
