INDIA Pray for the Co-creating Inclusive Development project team as they strive to open pathways to communities which are free from discrimination, have access to quality healthcare, and allow everyone to contribute to society.

Tuesday September 22

TIMOR-LESTE Pray for the team overseeing the operations of the newly refurbished clinic in Oecusse. Pray they will build good relationships with the community as they work towards handing responsibility to the Timor-Leste Government in the new year.

Wednesday September 23

TIMOR-LESTE Pray for partner organisations run by and for people affected by leprosy and disabilities as they provide important links to communities throughout Oecusse, helping identify people in need of support while undergoing treatment for leprosy.

Thursday September 24

GLOBAL Pray for the inner wellbeing of people affected by leprosy. Pray that they will find healing and acceptance through the love of God, evidenced in the work of Leprosy Mission workers and their partners.

Friday September 25

GLOBAL Pray for the families and friends of children affected by leprosy. Pray they will provide the love and support needed to overcome fear and

stigma and be a source of comfort and peace.

Saturday September 26

GLOBAL Pray for churches in implementing countries who provide practical support and resources for many of the projects you pray for. Pray this will help deliver holistic care and bring communities together.

Sunday September 27

GLOBAL Pray for open hearts and minds to work together to bring innovation across the Global Fellowship. Pray that new ideas will lead to meaningful change and breakthroughs for people affected by leprosy, disability, and discrimination.
