Following Jesus Christ, The Leprosy Mission strives to break the chains of leprosy, empowering people to attain healing, dignity, and life in all its fullness.

Position

Many people are unaware that every two minutes one person around the world is diagnosed with leprosy. You would be raising awareness of this in your community.

This is a vital role because as more people become aware of leprosy, there are more people praying, and more people supporting. This breaks more chains!

Tasks

You are willing to organise to distribute updates about people affected by leprosy to your community. This could be your church, your community group (ie Rotary), your local library, your local café or even your Bible Study Group (or all of them!).

You would ask whichever group, or groups if they would be happy to receive some literature about people affected by leprosy, what type of literature, how many copies would be appropriate, and how frequently.

You would let us know how much literature you needed sent, and how often you needed it sent. Then at those times you would receive a little parcel containing the relevant material. Then you would distribute that to the right location.

There are three pieces of literature appropriate to this: Our Action Magazine which comes out twice a year; Our Catalogue which comes out four times a year; our Keeping in Touch Newsletter, which contains prayer updates which comes out every month.

You are always able to speak to us if you have questions about what might be best. For instance you might just want to receive some of the Christmas Catalogue once a year to distribute to your friends

Skills

You love Jesus. You love people affected by leprosy. You are happy to talk to your local church, community group, library, café or Bible study group to see if they might like the updates. You have an address at which you can receive mail. You are able to deliver the resources you receive.

Setting

In your own home, and within your local community.

Schedule and commitment.

You can do this as long as you wish to. You do not need to sign up to a fixed term. It is as busy as you would like it to be. It ranges from getting the Christmas Catalogue once a year and distributing that. Or you can get the Keeping in Touch Newsletter once a month and be distributing that.
